To nominate graduate students for the Graduate Assistance in Areas of National Need Fellowship Program, please complete this form and **attach the following supporting documentation**: (1) letter of nomination from mentor, (2) a **detailed** description of the nominee's current or proposed research **and** how it relates to the nominee's respective GAANN research area (molecular biotechnology), (3) a statement of purpose from the nominee, to include interest and motivation for a career in academia, (4) the nominee's plan for completing the supervised teaching requirement including anticipated date of completion, (5) a copy of all undergraduate and graduate transcripts and, *if possible*, (6) a completed FAFSA form (can be sent later)\*. This application and supporting documentation should be completed and returned to Todd Marcks, the Graduate School, Box 7102.
