

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#### Message from the Acting Dean of the Graduate School

Duane Larick, Senior Vice Provost and Dean of the Graduate School, is working on special projects in the provost's office this year. As acting dean, I am pleased to present the latest version of the Annual Report on Graduate Education at NC State University. The purpose of this report is to spotlight our graduate education by presenting statistical information that describes the state of this critical part of the university's mission. The Graduate School has provided this information as one way of advancing its primary aim of supporting and improving graduate education.

Of course, the graphs presented here cannot tell the whole story. I am proud of the many contributions the Graduate School made in 2011-2012 to enhancing the quality of graduate education at NC State. This message gives me the opportunity to highlight some of those contributions.

Preparing Future Leaders (PFL) continues to provide extraordinary professional development to a growing number of graduate students and postdocs. This year we piloted the Season Pass, a certificate for participation in all three PFL themes, career skills, teaching and mentoring, and responsible conduct of research. Twelve graduate students earned these certificates. Overall, we offered 139 events, workshops and seminars with a total attendance of 3,044, including 2,567 graduate students, 432 postdocs, and 45 other participants. Our students accomplished quite a lot: 21 completed the Preparing the Professoriate program, 67 earned the Certificate of Accomplishment in Teaching, seven completed the Mentoring and Teaching Practicum, 22 completed the Graduate Leadership Development Series, and two earned the Certificate in Career Development.

We are among the nation's leaders in advancing Professional Science Master's (PSM) degrees. This year, NC State established 3 new PSM programs, Biomanufacturing, Climate Change and Society, and Electric Power Systems Engineering, along with two new concentrations in Computer Networking, and Crop Management and Improvement, bringing our total to 12 PSMs. We have also played a leadership role in promoting and developing PSMs at other universities in the UNC system through the UNC system-wide PSM Operations Group.

I was pleased that the results of our support for postdocs through our Office of Postdoctoral Affairs received national recognition. For the first time, *The Scientist* included NC State as one of the top 30 universities for postdocs, noting especially the positive conditions for family and personal life and equity.

We approved agreements for Cooperative Education Training in Veterinary Epidemiology with UNC-Chapel Hill, the dual-degree Master of Global innovation and Management with a concentration in Global Luxury Management with SKEMA Business School, and the FREEDM Systems Center Cooperative Agreement for Distance Access of Courses.

The Graduate School participated in the third annual Graduate Education Week on March 18-24, which included the annual Graduate Student Research Symposium, seminars and workshops, the "Outstanding Graduate Teaching Assistant" awards celebration, a service project for Habitat for

Humanity, and recreational opportunities. On Graduate Education Day, May 23, selected NC State graduate students joined others from across North Carolina to present research posters to state legislators at the legislative building.


We had good news for our diversity program. A no-cost extension was received for the \$10 million NSF Alliances for Graduate Education and the Professoriate program through February 2013. And NIH renewed NC State's IMSD program for \$3.6 million through 2017.


Degrees Conferred
Academic Years 2007-2011




#### Master's and Doctoral Degrees by College Academic Year 2011



#### Doctoral Degrees by College Academic Year 2011




#### Master's Degrees by College Academic Year 2011




### Degree Recipients by Gender Academic Years 2007-2011






### Master's Degree Recipients by Gender Academic Years 2007-2011




### Degree Recipients by Ethnicity and Citizenship Academic Years 2007-2011




### Doctoral Degree Recipients by Ethnicity and Citizenship Academic Years 2007-2011






### Degree Recipients by U.S. Minorities Academic Years 2007-2011



### Doctoral Degree Recipients by U.S. Minorities Academic Years 2007-2011




#### Master's Degree Recipients by US Minorities Academic Years 2007-2011



# Applications, Admitted Applicants and New Enrollments Academic Years 2007-2011 (Grad Degree Programs ONLY)




### Applications by Grad Degree Academic Years 2007-2011




#### Percentage of Degree Applicants Admitted Academic Years 2007-2011




## New Enrollments as a Percentage of Admitted Applicants Academic Years 2007-2011




### Grad Degree Applications by Gender Academic Years 2007-2011



#### Admitted Grad Degree Applicants by Gender Academic Years 2007-2011




#### New Grad Degree Enrollments by Gender Academic Years 2007-2011




### Grad Degree Applications by Citizenship Academic Years 2007-2011




#### Admitted Grad Degree Applicants by Citizenship Academic Years 2007-2011




### New Grad Degree Enrollments by Citizenship Academic Years 2007-2011








#### New Grad Degree Enrollments by U.S. Minorities Academic Years 2007-2011








### Undergraduate and Graduate Enrollment Fall 2007-2011




### Percentage of Undergraduate and Graduate Enrollment Fall 2007-2011




### Grad Enrollment by Degree Fall 2007-2011




### Enrollment for Full-Time and Part-Time Students Fall 2007-2011



### Enrollment by College Fall 2011




### Percentage of Enrollment by College Fall 2011




### Enrollment by Gender Fall 2007-2011




