- Update on the <u>Fair Standards Labor Act</u>
 - As of December 1st, postdocs need to make \$47,465, or they need to work less than 40 hours/week
 - More than half of the postdocs on NC State's are below this threshold
 - Postdocs who work more than 40 hours/week need to keep timesheets and get paid overtime
- New Science-Business Certificate
 - A new initiative from OPA, a one-year certificate program in partnership with the Poole College of Management to provide business and management skills specifically for science postdocs
 - o Is there interest in this certificate program?
 - o There is a potential cost associated:
 - One course with the Poole College of Management is \$3800
