

Wilkinson Graduate Ethics Fellowship

Program Summary

The Wilkinson Graduate Ethics Fellowship is a prestigious one-year award offered to one top new or continuing graduate student at NC State University in any discipline. The Fellowship is funded through an endowment given to the University by Walter H. Wilkinson, Jr. for the purpose of promoting ethics in research and professional practice.

Eligibility and Selection

This fellowship is available to all new or continuing full-time graduate students in any field of study. To be eligible for this fellowship, nominees must be in a course of study and/or engaged in a research project that focuses on professional ethics or responsible conduct in research.

Students may not apply directly for these fellowships. Instead, they must be [nominated](#) by their prospective Directors of Graduate Programs, who submit nomination materials to the Graduate School. Each completed nomination form must be accompanied by (1) two letters of recommendation, (2) a statement of purpose, and (3) a copy of the nominee's transcripts.

Selections are made by a committee of faculty appointed by the Graduate School.

Stipend and Fellowship Tenure

The Wilkinson Fellowship provides an annual stipend of \$5000 for a period of one year. Tuition, fees and health insurance are not covered.

Nomination Deadline

The [nomination](#) deadline for 2017-18 awards is March 1, 2017.
