




### Refund of Tuition and Fees

SIS will provide information to the student on the expected refund and withdrawal fees.

### This is UCO message student will see on withdraw application Refund of Tuition and Fees Based on your withdrawal date of June 28, 2016, you may expect a 50% refund or reduction of your tuition and fees for the Summer2 term. At this time, administrative charges are estimated at \$86.93. These amounts are estimates, and can change if your withdrawal date is changed or other charges are applied to your account. Tuition and fee refunds or reductions for Official Withdrawals are prorated based on the date of the withdrawal. No refunds are made for official withdrawals after 50% of the enrollment period. Please refer to https://treasurer.ofb.ncsu.edu/cashier/refunds/withdraw.php for a schedule of withdrawal dates for the current term(s). An administrative fee of 5% of the total tuition and fees, and late registration fee charges not to exceed \$100, will be charged for all withdrawals processed. The administrative fee will post to your account after the processing of your withdrawal. Refunds will not be processed until after the official drop period (Census) and will be deposited to the student's bank account or mailed to the student's university home/mailing address. The Census date for the Summer2 term is June 27, 2016. Students have the right to file a refund application (an appeal) in the Student Accounts Section of the University Cashier's Office at https://treasurer.ofb.ncsu.edu/cashier/forms/appeal.php . The appeal must be substantiated by medical reasons, unexpected employment changes, death in the immediate family, or University error and will be reviewed by the University Fee Appeals Committee. The appeal can not be processed if you have received academic credit for the course. The deadline for filing an appeal is the last day of exams for the term. 



# **University Housing & University Dining**


SIS will provide information to students in Housing and/or with Dining plans.






### **Athletes and International Students**
