Contractual Readmission for Master's Students

In rare circumstances, a program may request that the Graduate School contractually readmit a student. Contractual readmission permits students, who had previously been enrolled in a master's program at NC State and obtained GPAs below a 3.00, to pursue a master's degree in another field and have their GPAs reset. The program requesting this readmission must be different from the one in which the student was originally enrolled. Students must complete the Graduate Contractual Readmission form and this must be approved by the new program's DGP and the Graduate School. This process will not remove the previous coursework from their NC State transcript, but it will allow the calculation of the graduate GPA to commence when they enroll in the new program. Furthermore, this process requires a break in enrollment; the coursework for the prior program must have been completed at least four years prior to the term in which the student will re-enroll.
