What is the GSSP?

The Graduate Student Support Plan (GSSP) is a financial support package to attract top students to NC State University.

Graduate students eligible for the Plan receive **tuition*** and **health insurance** benefits at no cost to them.

Size & Scope – FY 2023

Participation:

Over **3,500 students**; ~ **53%** of all on-campus graduate students

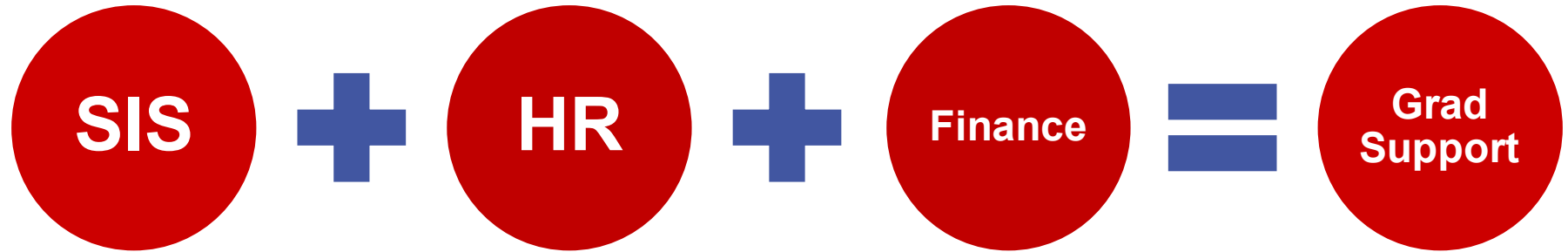
Funding:

Over **\$63.3 million**

- **\$ 45.1M** – Graduate School (Provost allocated funding)
- **\$ 18.4M** – Other Funding Sources (non-state funding sources, including grants)
 - » **\$14M** – Contracts and Grants



Eligibility information flows through the HR System, Financial System and Student Information System for calculation in Grad Support:



- Academic eligibility criteria
- Which benefits and how long?

- **Appointment type**
- **Duration**

- Who pays for which benefit
 - Based on project

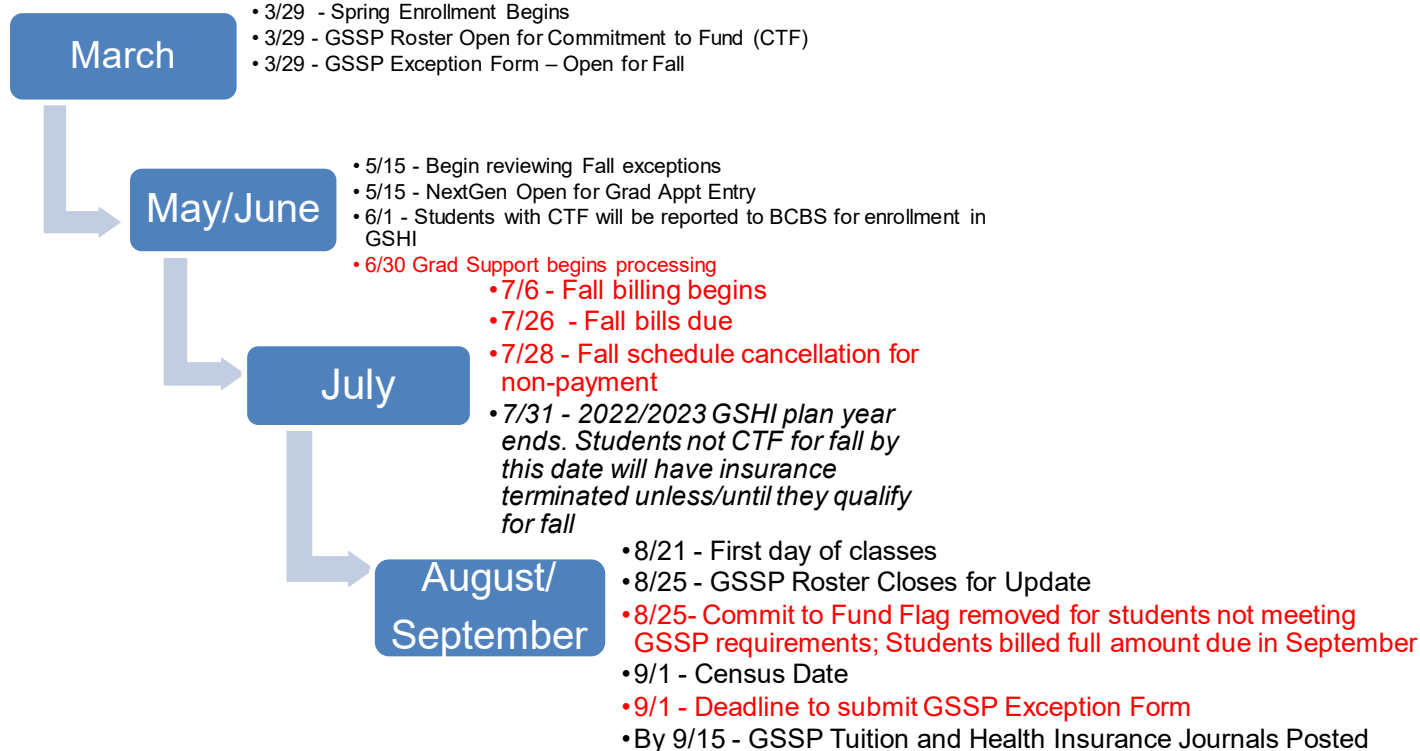
- Complete eligibility criteria
- Duration of benefits

Receiving Benefits

- For students to receive benefits, **the graduate appointment (and all other [eligibility requirements](#)) must be fully approved by all parties by Census Day (10th day of classes).**
 - Appointment fully approved

 - OR
 - The Department has informed the Graduate School via the commit to fund that they intend to add an eligible appointment

GSSP Timeline – Fall 2023



NEW Minimum Stipend Increase

- Effective **Fall 2023**, the minimum stipend to qualify for GSSP benefits has increased
 - \$10,000 for Master's students
 - \$15,000 for Doctoral students
- Effective **Fall 2024**, the minimum stipend to qualify for GSSP benefits will increase:
 - \$15,000 annualized for Master's students
 - \$20,000 annualized for Doctoral students



Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 Stipend Breakdown

Health Insurance Updates and Reminders

- [RA-TA GSHI](#) plan is separate from the [University's Mandatory Student Health Insurance Plan](#). RA-TA rates:
 - Fall 2023 GSHI premium - \$1,288.75
 - Spring 2024 GSHI premium - \$1,804.25
- Allows for dependent enrollment, at the expense of the student
- **Co-pay model**
 - **Students previously had to meet deductible first**
 - **RA-TA insurance Video – to be posted by BCBS in Blue Connect**

Salary Redistribution Reminders

- GSSP process captures funding data as of Census Day
 - Any changes after Census are **not captured**, even if backdated
 - HR actions impact financials and GSSP
 - Departments must [notify the graduate school](#) if SDC's impact [state funds](#).
- Use our **new** [Funding Structure tool](#) as general guidance to determine “who pays” for which GSSP benefit!

Key Reminders

- **TIMING**
 - Billing date – July 6
 - Bill due date – July 26
 - Spring Health Insurance Termination- July 31
- Fall appointments should be entered **now**
- Communicate with the student's academic home department if they are working outside of the department regarding:
 - Eligibility
 - Exceptions
 - Commitment to fund
- **If a grant cannot pay tuition, do not hire the student on a GSSP eligible (or split) appointment**
 - Recommended to use for summer funding
 - Hire on a different grant
 - Or prearrange alternate funding

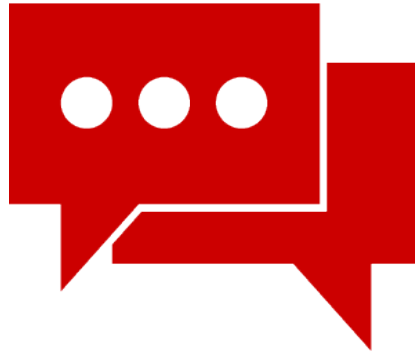
