Residency determination is handled through the NC Residency Determination Service (RDS); note that students should only submit an RDS application after they have been physically present in NC for one full year or longer. It is imperative that new out-of-state students, who intend to apply for in-state residency in Fall 2024, begin their residency acts as soon as they arrive in NC. Some examples of residency acts include getting a NC driver's license, registering to vote, registering a vehicle, and further actions which demonstrate ties to NC. It is advised that students utilize walk-in appointments for the DMV, as online appointments are not available until several months from now.
