Admissions Required Training

Everyone with active Slate (and/or GradWatch) access was assigned to the required admissions training in Reporter. The training is two-part, there is a 26 minute video AND an acknowledgement (quiz) that must be completed to finish the requirement. Users will get reminders to complete the training if they haven't done both parts. Note that anyone from here forward needing Slate or GradWatch access or who will be involved with admissions application reviews must take the training.
