Admissions

Coming Soon - Admissions Required Training in Reporter for all involved in application intake, review, evaluation or whose opinion is sought on the qualifications of an applicant. This training was created in response to the U.S. Supreme Court ruling on race in admissions and everyone should complete the 26 minute training prior to reviewing applications for the 2024 admissions cycle.

We have loaded everyone with Slate access into Reporter for this training and you will receive an email with a link to this required training soon. Note: your faculty and application reviewers who have a unity ID and Slate access will also receive the notification for the training. If you have reviewers who are outside of the university (without an @ncsu.edu email), they will need a brickyard (guest) account in order to complete the training.
